Reading Lesson	Students play "That's Me" – sitting in a circle, students share a fact about themselves. When someone shares the same fact, they stand up and say "ME TOO!" Students have an open conversation about what it means to be a good listener in class. Teacher reads My Mouth is a Volcano. Students listen to story and discuss events throughout (What they see/wonder) in the text.
